

Planets arouse interest of commodity seekers

Not only the cancri e known as the diamond planet, which could also be made of sapphire, but other planets also lure with raw materials.

Space is the final frontier for resource exploration and exploitation. The comet between Mars and Jupiter known as Psyche 16 is famous. He is said to have enough gold so that every human being on earth could be a billionaire, with 83 billion euros each.

NASA is currently planning a mission to Psyche 16, which is scheduled to begin in 2022. In 2026, the mission would have reached the comet and could have started with detailed investigations. Psyche 16 was discovered as early as 1852 by an astronomer.

The possibility of mining water on the moon with the use in space, not on earth, is also seriously considered. According to a study conducted by a Canadian mining company, opportunities similar to the development of the Internet are expected here. The valuable raw materials are also usually found on the surface of the asteroids. As long as the mining of space raw materials is still pure planning, it is preferable to concentrate for the time being on the raw material companies that can demonstrate success on Earth.
